Set and costume designs from the 20th century's Ballets Russes 1909-1929

At its core is a significant collection of original art commissioned for the Ballets Russes.

Company forged a new aesthetic that continues to influence the visual and performing arts.

The majority of designs are by Russian-born artists, other nationalities who contributed designs to the Ballets Russes are well represented.

The collection mirrors the artistic movements prevalent in the theater during the early 20th century:

- -nationalistic and folk-influenced
- -cubist and constructivist
- -neo-romantic designs
- -orientalist designs
- -abstract impressionism
- -realism



sorting

arrange systematically in groups; separate according to type.

taxonomising

concerned with classification; an ordered arrangement of groups or categories; orderly classification according to their presumed natural relationships

classifying

arrange (a group of people or things) in classes or categories according to shared qualities or characteristics.

captioning

provide (an illustration) with a title or explanation; shows when, what, and where it was taken, found, or executed

framing

form or articulate (words); construct (something) by fitting parts together or in accordance with a plan; the <u>underlying constructional system</u> or structure that gives shape

recontextualizing

place or consider in a new or different context

adding

to include as a member of a group to serve as an addition

subtracting

to take away by or as if by deducting

stretching

to extend in length to enlarge or distend especially by force

compressing |

to press or squeeze together & reduce in size, quantity, or volume; pressed together or into a smaller space

hijacking

take over (something) and use it for a different purpose; unlawfully seize and force it to go to a different destination

subverting

to overturn or overthrow pervert or corrupt

exaggerating

to enlarge beyond bounds or increase especially beyond the normal

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








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


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GOOGLE IMAGE SEARCH HIJACK /
